About Us

The Battlefield Equestrian Society (BES), founded in 1985, is a volunteer organization. Its purposes include maintaining and improving the equestrian trails in the Manassas National Battlefield Park (MNBP), promoting horsemanship through educational programs and activities, and general support of the Park.

Membership fees account for approximately one quarter of BES's annual revenue. Funds raised by the BES through its trail rides are donated to the Park along with voluntary labor to sustain the bridle system. The work of this service oriented group was recognized in 1994 when it was awarded the MNBP Partnership Award and in 1990 with the U.S. Interior Department's "Take Pride in America" Award.

The ongoing activities of the Society, in partnership with MNBP, include erosion control, trail trimming, and safety improvements to the Battlefield's bridle trails. BES also maintains a therapeutic riding trail and ramp for challenged equestrians.

Join today and be part of the BES and the preservation of America's equestrian history.

As Prince William County and the surrounding area loses its rural character in the wake of expanding development, places to ride become more difficult to find. We seek to insure the historic battlefield at Manassas remains a setting where equestrians can go to honor and appreciate an era in which so many Americans nobly fought here in defense of their freedoms and ideals and enjoy some of the beautiful countryside our nation has to offer.

When the Battlefield Equestrian Society was formed in 1985 by a small group of equestrians, it was with the resolve that even a small group of people can make a difference. Today we celebrate many achievements that have made improvements to the Park and to the visitor's experience. BES has donated just over \$850,000 in cash, goods and services and continues to donate to Manassas National Battlefield Park thanks to our supporters and members.

The Clifton Horse Society was formed in January 1977, by a small group of horse owners in the Clifton area who felt that their equestrian experiences would be enhanced by the coordination and cohesiveness of a club; a club with a substantial membership to draw upon financially, physically and mentally that would be able to offer educational clinics, put on competitive activities, sponsor deserving individuals or groups needing money to increase their abilities or services, have trail rides, encourage the development of a trail system, work with landowners and county and park officials to promote good relations between riders and those whose goodwill is essential to riders, and generally have a great time enjoying their horses and each other.

The original group wrote up a prospectus and stuffed it in mailboxes all over the Clifton area, and then reserved the Clifton Fire Hall for a meeting for March 1977, holding their breath to see if anyone would show up. To everyone's relief and delight, over ninety people came to the first meeting, and the Clifton Horse Society was born. The idea caught on like a house afire and the club has never slowed down. It immediately began publishing a newsletter, originally called Hoofbeats and later changed to Lead Line after a contest to choose a name.

Among our original members we discovered that no one equestrian discipline dominated. The club had trail riders, dressage enthusiasts, hunter/jumper showers, fox hunters, saddle seat riders, civil war re-enactors, parade riders, combined training buffs, and even more. It was decided that variety was the spice of life and that CHS would actively encourage its members to venture outside their own particular disciplines to try other forms of equestrian life. Eventually, of this philosophy was born the Proteus Award, given each year to the horse and rider team demonstrating the most versatility.

Since 1977 there have been clinics, competitive rides, Ride and Ties, horse shows, barn dances, dinner dances, trail rides, farm tours, picnics, gymkhanas, knowdowns, trips to the races, cocktail parties, monthly board meetings, pony rides at Clifton Day, parades, trip to the Washington International Horse Show, auctions, hay rides, Christmas caroling, and scholarships. Plus CHS has helped to establish a viable trail system all over the Clifton area and has cooperated in saving and producing trails in our local parks and developments, and even influenced horse-oriented legislation.

In accomplishing these phenomenal goals, CHS has enjoyed the support of neighborhood tack shops, veterinarians, farriers, local park authorities, various county officials and offices, but mostly CHS has been successful because of the real interest and support of its members. Some members join CHS mainly to receive the Lead Line, and that is fine; but hopefully, once they get a foot in the door, CHS, we hope, will lure them out to join in its activities and eventually contribute to produce those activities for the better enjoyment of all.

It's a funny thing, but very true, that the more you join in, the more fun you have in CHS, and the more you learn and progress as an equestrian. Every year CHS produces a whole new year of exciting events and projects. Don't just read about them. Come out and join in the fun.

CHS Scholarships, Grants and Awards Available. One of the great benefits CHS offers is providing financial assistance to individuals or organizations in pursuing research, careers, or other activities that will benefit the horse industry. CHS has helped many individuals fulfill their goal to contribute meaningful research or other services to advance the knowledge and well being of our four-legged friends. Individuals or organizations engaged in an activity that contributes significantly to equine knowledge or services are encouraged to apply for financial assistance through the CHS Scholarships, Awards & Grants Program. Participation in CHS activities provides camaraderie with others of similar interests and fosters sharing, learning, and meeting new friends. CHS's monthly newsletter, Lead Line, includes articles about horse care and horsemanship, trail and pasture maintenance, other articles of interest, classified advertisements, and a calendar of CHS events and other area horse organizations' activities. Members also receive a club roster with members' telephone numbers and addresses (postal and e-mail). Annual membership dues are \$20 for individual or \$30 for family membership. We also have biannual memberships for \$35 for individual or \$55 for family membership.



Fairfax4Horses

Fairfax4Horses is dedicated to the establishment of public riding facilities on Fairfax County parkland and to the promotion of equestrian activities throughout the County. Because most riding stables in the area closed as development expanded, adults and children who would like to enjoy the benefits of horseback riding were not able to do so. Fairfax4Horses works with the Fairfax County Park Authority (FCPA), the equestrian community, private organizations, and others to establish riding facilities at which County residents can take lessons and board horses.

In September 2001, several equestrians testified at a hearing of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, supporting the need for public riding facilities in the County. Most area riding stables had closed as a result of rising land values and expanded development that made it impractical for these facilities to remain in business. Two of the three large lesson and boarding barns in the County were closing (Great Falls Horse Center in November 2001) or were in danger of closing (Bay Ridge Stables closed in August 2002). Before they

closed, both facilities maintained large riding lesson programs, so many opportunities to learn to ride were lost.

Fairfax4Horses sponsored a meeting in October 2002 at the Great Falls Grange, where a coalition of equestrians and individuals interested in maintaining open space in the County began organizing to create opportunities for horseback riding lesson facilities on County parkland.

Fairfax4Horses incorporated in September 2004 and received 501(c)(3) non-profit status in May 2005. During this time, members of the organization regularly attended FCPA planning meetings to promote the establishment of public riding facilities. Laurel Hill Park, formerly the site of Lorton Prison, was identified as a promising location for a riding facility, and the FCPA approved a master plan for Laurel Hill Park that included a site for an equestrian center. A 60-acre parcel of land was set aside for a stable, indoor arena, outdoor rings, and pasture, and a site plan and infrastructure for the Laurel Hill Equestrian Center are in progress. As Fairfax4Horses members continued to attend FCPA meetings, an additional land parcel was identified for riding facilities and included in the master plan for the new Sully Woodlands Park.



In Spring 2010, Fairfax4Horses, working with Park Manager Tawny Hammond, was instrumental in establishing a

pilot lesson program for beginning riders at the County's Frying Pan Park. The lesson program already has a substantial waiting list, providing convincing evidence of the demand for horseback riding lessons in Fairfax County.

FRIDA ICELANDIC HORSE CLUB

The Icelandic horse has a thousand year history. Purebred since the 10th century, the Icelandic horse is renowned for being hardy, athletic, independent, spirited, friendly, adaptable, and sure-footed with four or five natural gaits. These are the walk, trot, canter, tolt, and pace.

The tolt is an extremely smooth four-beat gait, much like the running walk or rack that allows the rider a virtually bounce-free ride at speeds up to 20 mph. The tolt is a natural gait; no artificial aids are needed.

Averaging 13 to 14 hands tall, the Icelandic horse is versatile family riding horse, bred to carry adults at fast pleasing gait over long distances. It's easy going, friendly disposition make the Icelandic horse an ideal companion for the entire family. In addition to formal horse shows and competitions, Icelandic horses are used widely for cross-country rides and long-distance trekking. They also compete in eventing, dressage, jumping, and endurance races.

FRIDA ICELANDIC HORSE CLUB (FIRC): Icelandic horse owners and members of the United States Icelandic Horse Congress (USIHC), meeting at the Maryland Horse Expo in the winter of 2002, thought that forming a regional chapter under the USIHC would be a good way to honor the memory of Frida Gudmundsdottir, who worked hard to bring them together to share love of the Icelandic horse as well as to continue her work.

The club holds meetings and conducts activities in an area that includes Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, and Maryland. Activities include schooling shows, trail rides, video nights, socials, drill team practices, and clinics throughout the region. Clinicians are usually top trainers from Iceland, Germany, and the United States. Members range in age from 9 to 80+.

You do not have to own an Icelandic horse or be a member of the United States Icelandic Horse Congress to join. If you are an admirer of the Icelandic horse and live in the mid-Atlantic region, please join us.

Great Falls Horse Network

Connecting Horse Owners and Riders in the Great Falls Area

The **Great Falls Horse Network** evolved from the **Great Falls Equestrian Society** (GFES) and the Save-the-Farm Team (now the **Friends of Turner Farm** (FOTF)). These two groups formed in the early 90's to promote the interests of equestrians in the Great Falls area.

Originally, GFES focused on maintaining access to trails, particularly in Great Falls National Park. The Save-the-Farm Team was formed to help establish public equestrian and other facilities on the site of the former Turner Dairy Farm.

These two groups were largely successful in achieving their goals, but ongoing efforts to organize the Great Falls equestrian community were hampered by inability to communicate efficiently with members. Traditional mail is costly and time-consuming and few people have time or interest in attending meetings after work. Horse people want to be with their horses!

This led us to the Great Falls Horse Network. Our goal is to provide online tools for horse owners and riders in the Great Falls area to communicate and share information about equestrian issues and activities in our area.

The Network is a work in progress. We rely on volunteers to maintain the website and lead group activities. We are an informal organization. We don't have dues, by-laws, elections and meet only when necessary. We need participation and feedback from all members to know what interests our members and how to serve them better.



The Loudoun Hunt

Est. 1894

Located in the beautiful hunt country in and around Leesburg, VA



The Loudoun County Hunt Club (now known as The Loudoun Hunt) was established in 1894 and recognized by NSHA (Natl. Steeplechase and Hunt Assoc.) in 1905. From 1906 to 1908 the Hunt Kennels were located at Westmoreland Davis's Morven Park. In 1929 the Hunt was recorded by Master of Fox Hounds Association, and the kennels are now located in Leesburg.

Foxhunting is the sport of mounted riders chasing wild quarry with a pack of hounds. It is a union of humans and animals in the beauty of nature's setting. According to the Masters of Foxhounds Association of America, Englishman Robert Brooke was the first man to import hunting hounds to America, bringing his pack to Maryland in 1650 when he imported his horses and a pack of foxhounds. Also around this time, numbers of European red foxes were introduced into the Eastern seaboard of North America for hunting. The first organized hunt for the benefit of a group (rather than a single patron) was started by Thomas, sixth Lord Fairfax in 1747. In the United States, George Washington and Thomas Jefferson both kept packs of fox hounds before and after the American Revolutionary War.


The horses, called "field hunters" or hunters, ridden by followers of the hunt, are a prominent feature of many hunts. Horses on hunts can range from specially bred and trained field hunters to casual hunt attendees riding a wide variety of horse and pony types. Draft and Thoroughbred crosses are commonly used as hunters, although purebred Thoroughbreds and horses of many different breeds are also used. Hunters must be well-mannered, have the athletic ability to clear large obstacles such as wide ditches, tall fences, and rock walls, and have the stamina to keep up with the hounds. There are two groups in the field, the first field and the hilltoppers. Although the hilltoppers do not jump, they too must be physically capable of moving on at a fast pace to closely follow the first field.

The popularity of foxhunting continues to grow. There are now 167 organized clubs in North America and Canada and organized member hunts exist in 36 states. There are many reasons for its popularity. There is an old adage that says, "some people ride to hunt, others hunt to ride". Certainly the thrill of galloping over the countryside on a fine horse, who meets his fences well, is a thrill for anyone. Also, the sight of a pack of hounds in full cry is breathtaking. Today's hunters have a special reward, the permission to ride over private and public land which still constitutes magnificent open spaces. No group of individuals is more aware of this privilege, nor is there a group more outspoken in their desire to protect quarry and preserve their environment. It is enjoyed by people from all walks of life and any age. It is a wonderful recreation for the whole family that can be enjoyed for a lifetime.



With our staff and dedicated volunteers NVTRP provides horseback riding lessons seven days a week. Horseback riding has been shown to be one of the most beneficial forms of recreation for people with all types of disabilities.

NVTRP offers service to a wide range of children/adults with special needs. When riding a horse, our students are given the opportunity to feel freedom and power through movement.

As the horse walks, the movement is transferred to the rider, providing a combination of sensory, motor, and neurological stimulation. This translates to stronger muscles, better balance and coordination, improved gait and, just as important, greater self-confidence and self-esteem.

NO MAN'S LAND BACK COUNTRY HORSEMEN

No Man's Land Back Country Horsemen is a newly formed unit of the Back Country Horsemen of America (BCHA), a national organization dedicated to keeping trails on public lands open to equine use. Founded in the 1970s in the west, the BCHA is moving east because of growing pressure on federal and state agencies to close trails to equines. Nationally BCHA has thousands of members.

Like many horse groups, No Man's Land Back Country Horsemen will have trail rides, but our primary activity is working closely with the National Forest, National Park and State Park agencies. This work includes volunteer trail maintenance and local policy action, especially opposing rule changes that adversely impact equine use on trails. We also work to open trails that are presently closed to equines. Many trails on federal lands in the south have been closed to equines and the trend is spreading into Virginia.


No Man's Land BCH will focus on the George Washington/Jefferson National Forest in VA and WV, Monongahela National Forest in WV and Shenandoah National Park. Our Parks and Forests are the closest public back country to the Nation's Capital. We want them to be models of national equine policy.

Our members come from a wide region, from West Virginia to metro DC. You do not have to ride to be a member, just have a concern for keeping trails open. We are particularly interested in trail riding as a form of recreation for seniors.

Annual dues for No Man's Land Back Country Horsemen are \$5 junior, \$10 adult, \$16 family, \$20 associate. A junior member is under 16 and not part of a family membership. An associate member is a business or other organization. Dues are for the calendar year in which they are paid. The dues to the national organization are payable January 1 each year and are included in our dues.

About the name No Man's Land. This is a rugged region in the northern tip of GW/J NF that offers exceptional back country trail riding in VA and WV. Which county and state it belonged to was in dispute until well into the 20th century, so land titles were unclear, hence the name.

Promoting trail riding in the Shenandoah Valley since 1988

The Shenandoah Valley has some of the most beautiful scenery and riding trails anywhere in the United States. In 1988, a group of Shenandoah County horse owners decided to form a riding club to take advantage of these lovely trails. The club was an immediate success, and during the past fifteen years it has sponsored over 350 trail rides in the area. Many of the trails are in the George Washington National Forest, but a number of private landowners allow us to ride on their property as well. We try to vary the length, difficulty, and terrain of our trail rides to suit the varied interests and abilities of our members.

Our rides have included:

- **Childrens/Novice Rides** of short duration on easy trails. The 4-H is often invited to join us on these rides.
- **Longer rides on rocky mountain terrain** that are suitable only for experienced riders and sure-footed horses. The scenery is well worth the difficulty of these rides.
- **Road rides**, especially suited for gaited horses.
- **Overnight rides**
- **Rides featuring picnics, cookouts, covered dish dinners, etc.**

We have sponsored rides as short as two hours and as long as eight hours. The average number of riders on any given ride is approximately fifteen, but we have also had rides with fifty riders.

Other activities that the club has been involved in (past and present) include:

- Parades
- Working with the U.S. Forest Service to build or improve trails and to upgrade access to existing trails.
- An annual competitive trail ride, the Shenandoah 25, which was sanctioned by ECTRA, a national organization
- Club sponsored horse shows
- Trips to events of interest to our members such as horse shows and races (ie. Reserved trackside seating at Shenandoah Races).
- Working with local and state legislators on any legislation that directly affects trail riding or other horse-related activities in the state.
- Spring and Fall Judged Trail Rides
- Assist other horse-related non-profit organizations with donations
- Sponsor an annual St. Jude's Children's Hospital benefit ride

We have approximately 60 families in the club, many from outside the Shenandoah County area. New members are always welcome. Family membership for one year costs \$15.00. A single membership costs \$10.00.






